### PARK WARD NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLAN

### Publication Stage Regulation 16 Representation Form

Park Ward Neighbourhood Forum has prepared a Neighbourhood Development Plan (PWNP). The Plan sets out a vision for the future of the area and planning policies which will be used to determine planning applications locally. In accordance with Regulation 16 of the Neighbourhood Planning Regulations 2012 (as amended), the PWNP and associated documents will go out to consultation (**Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> February 2022 until Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> March 2022**) for 6 weeks inviting representations on the draft submission plan, basic conditions statement, and consultation statement.
