An exciting new opportunity has arisen to support families identified at risk of perinatal mental health issues.

The role will include working with children and parents as a part of our community outreach which will include both home visits and facilitating groups.

Perinatal-Mental Health support is delivered as a part of our joint working with health partners and involves working with mothers from about 32 weeks of pregnancy until the end of a baby's first year.

This post comes with opportunities to complete training in specific areas such as Baby Massage. It will involve close working with health professionals.

- GCSE or equivalent qualification in Maths and English
- An ability to build and maintain relationships with multi-agency colleagues
- A non-judgemental, patient and sensitive approach to families under stress
