## **REQUIREMENTS/EXPECTATIONS**

- Minimum of one Instagram grid post or reel, TikTok video and/or Facebook post
- Made live before 3rd November
- Remains live throughout bonfire season/celebrations
- Tag @wyfrs
- Direct people to the campaign landing page at www.westyorksfire.gov.uk/bonfire-night-safety
- Use #BonfireSafe
- Send your image(s) and caption to <u>amy.kot@westyorksfire.gov.uk</u> or @wyfrs on Instagram or TikTok for proofing prior to posting
- Ensure the post or reel is set up as a collaboration on Instagram and enable the 'Disclose post content' toggle on TikTok
- Ensure your analytics is on/accessible before posting on TikTok (found through creator tools)
- If you exhibit any behaviours that contradict current restrictions, you will be terminated from the campaign
